<u>ORDER</u>

The Court is in receipt of Plaintiffs' Report Concerning Compliance with Order
Regarding Uncashed Settlement Funds; the supplemental declaration of Plaintiffs'
counsel, Jonathan Melmed; and the supplemental declaration of the Kim Ness of JND
Legal Administration LLC—the settlement administrator in this case. Dkt. No. 731.

The Court finds that there is expected to exist a residue of at least \$12,028.50 in
uncashed settlement funds, plus approximately \$24,291.63 in unspent administrative
costs and fees (a portion of which is expected to be spent in finalizing the distribution
process in this case). The Court further finds that the process of re-issuing settlement
funds is still ongoing. Accordingly, the Court orders the Settlement Administrator to:

A. Reject any additional re-issue requests received after September 30, 2024;

B. Inform class members of the September 30, 2024, deadline for reissue requests by posting that deadline on the settlement website; and

C. After the void date is reached for any checks made as a result of a timely re-issue request has passed, distribute the remaining funds in the settlement fund (minus any additional administration costs) to St. Christopher Truckers Relief Fund as the *cy pres* recipient. Administration costs must be provided and approved to Plaintiffs' counsel before deducting that amount and issuing the remainder to the *cy pres* recipient.
