Plaintiffs' Motion for Approval of Notice to Settlement Class Members and Appointment of Settlement Administrator (the "Notice Motion") came before this Court. The Court finds this matter suitable for decision without oral argument and vacates the hearing set for April 15, 2022. Fed. R. Civ. P. 78; L.R. 7-15. The Court, having considered the papers submitted by the parties, HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The Court grants Plaintiffs' Motion for Approval of Notice to Settlement Class Members and Appointment of Settlement Administrator.
- 2. This Court approves, as to form and content, the postcard, email, and long form Notice, in substantially the forms attached to the Declaration of Ian Gore as Exhibits A-C. The Court approves the procedure for Settlement Class members to participate in, to opt out of, or to object to the Settlements as set forth in the Notice Motion.
- 3. The Court directs the dissemination of the postcard and email notices by first class mail and email, respectively, to the Settlement Class members in accordance with the proposed plan of notice in the Notice Motion. The Court finds that the proposed notice plan meets the requirements of due process and provides the best notice practicable under the circumstances and shall constitute due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled thereto.
- 4. The Court appoints JND Class Action Administration as the Settlement Administrator.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
